The Valuers are responsible for investigating claims of damage to livestock caused by wildlife, as outlined in the Ontario Wildlife Damage Compensation Program, and Livestock and Poultry caused by dogs, in accordance with the *Protection of Livestock and Poultry from Dogs Act*.

The Valuer completes a written report and submits a copy to the Municipal Clerk and the owner. Knowledge of the Ontario Wildlife Damage Compensation Program, *Protection of Livestock and Poultry from Dogs Act*, along with knowledge of fair livestock market value is required.

Remuneration for this position is \$100.00 per call plus mileage.
